I would have never dreamed, a little kid from Goodman, Missouri , would ever meet, let alone, become very good friends with famous people.

Arkansas, Came Home

Peggy and myself were in management positions with Sears & Roe Buck, in Fayetteville, Ark, and life was great. Our plans were to stay with Sears and retire. However, I received my draft notice to report to Kansas City, Mo for physical. I knew I was in perfect shape, I had just came home from playing professional baseball with the Yankees . They gave me test I had never heard of, and found me perfectly health. The news was, once you reached KC and passed the physical, I would go straight to Leonard Wood for basic training.

Peg and myself quit our jobs, and returned home, so Peggy could be with her folks, since we were expecting our first child. A week before I was to report to KC, I received a letter from the Army, telling me I didn't need to report for physical, since they had reclassified me.

Both unemployed and bills to pay. We started attending are home Church since we were back home. I will never forget the first Sunday Morning in Sunday School. The lesson was about a widow, and all she had was two mites, and she gave it to God.

Widows Mite

Mark 12:41-44 kjv

41 And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.
42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.
43 And he called *unto him* his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:
44 for all *they* did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living.

I was deeply touched by the story. I said God, I don't know what a mite is worth, but I don't even have a mite. In fact I am probably four mites in the hole. After Church and dinner, Peg was laying down in the bedroom and I was standing in front of a large mirror in our living room. I sad, God I don't know anything about bankruptcy, but I don't know what I'm going to do. People won't hire me, since I might be drafted any minute. If you will get me out of this mess, I will tithe, but after I pay my bills. I created the bills before I knew I was to tithe, and I believe the bills come first.

To make a long story short, **I got a job**, Sears terminated Peggy,(she was on pregnancy leave)sent us the money she had in retirement and we borrowed some money from my Grandparents. We never missed a payment.

A few months later, we purchase the property where we live today, for nothing down and monthly payment of \$25.00. The same amount we were paying to park our mobile home. After moving our mobile home to the property, I was walking in front of the trailer, and God said, thought you were going to tithe. I didn't reply, just bowed my head and kept walking. As each week went by I moved up in my job and received more money. I became supervisor over the Springfield Office, and had to drive my car a lot of miles. Each month I had car trouble, and the amount to repair my car was about the amount I should have tithe. After, three months of this, I realized God could stomp me like a bug. Peggy was ready to tithe way before this, I was the one dragging my feet, We started tithing. (continued in Sam Walton Story)

The Jerry Capehart Story

As we approached Goodman one Sunday Morning, Peggy said I told a family we would pickup their children up for Sunday School and Church. As Peggy reached the door, the mother said, I am on drugs and an alcoholic. Peg said, come to Church, we would like to have you there. The children went with us, and Jerry and Elaine came to Church. Jerry and family never missed a Sunday and brought their friends Jim Martin and family to Church. The Martins and our family started going to Capehart's for lunch, after Church.

After lunch, Jerry would play the guitar and sing songs. At this time Peg and I had no Idea, Jerry was a song writer or what he had done, before coming to Goodman.

Jerry Capehart credentials and achievements

JERRY CAPEHART was the producer and songwriter who, with Eddie Cochran, co-wrote the rock 'n' roll anthems "Summertime Blues" and "C'mon Everybody". In October 1955, Capehart came across the young Cochran in Bell Gardens, California. "I met him in a small music store," Capehart would tell journalists later. "I was in to buy guitar picks and he was looking for guitar strings. I had been searching for someone to make demonstration records of my songs and the store owner introduced me to Eddie, who I think was 17 at the time."

Cochran and Capehart really hit it off. The singer had just formed the Cochran Brothers with Hank Cochran (although the two were not related). The duo had made the switch from hillbilly music to the more potent brand of rock 'n' roll they had seen Elvis Presley pioneer on stage.

Capehart, who had fought in the Korean war, was already a songwriter of some repute. In 1951, he had composed "Beautiful Brown Eyes" and seen both Rosemary Clooney and the country vocalist Jimmy Wakely take the song into the American charts. However, Capehart's own singing career, under various guises (including the names Jerry Berryhill and Jerry Neal), had not proved as successful, and he started using the Cochran Brothers to cut demos of his songs. He also pitched the recordings to prospective record companies. When "Walkin' Stick Boogie" appeared on the Cash label in 1956, it was credited to "Jerry Capehart featuring the Cochran Brothers". On Ekko, "Tired and Sleepy" / "Fool's Paradise" was just by the Cochran Brothers. However, the "square"-looking Hank seemed to be holding the other two back and he eventually left for Nashville, while Eddie went solo. Capehart became Cochran's co-writer, producer, manager and confidant.

The pair spent hours in the studio, creating and overdubbing instrumental tracks like "Guybo" (named after the bassist Connie "Guybo" Smith who played on most of the recordings) and gaining a mastery of the studio which would later stand them in good stead. They also put out the odd single by Jewel & Eddie and the Kelly Four on Capehart's labels, Silver and Capehart Records, while Cochran supplemented his income with session dates as a lead guitarist. All the while, Capehart, convinced he had found a real gem, was hustling Cochran around the Californian music industry.

American Music, a Hollywood publishing company, eventually released Cochran's first solo single, "Skinny Jim", on their Crest label in 1956. Encouraged by this break, Capehart took the singer into the famous Gold Star studios (later used by the ace producer Phil Spector) to cut more demos. "Twenty Flight Rock" turned out well, and armed with this and three other tracks, Capehart secured a recording contract for his charge with Si Waronker of Liberty Records who just happened to be on the lookout for his own Elvis Presley. Around the same time, Cochran was also spotted by the movie- producer Boris Petroff who booked him to provide backing music on a soundtrack. He also offered Cochran a part in The Girl Can't Help It, the John Shanklin movie featuring the ample charms of Jayne Mansfield and the creme de la creme of a new musical genre. With his quiff, his moody look and his trademark Gretsch 6120 guitar, Cochran caught teenagers' imagination as he performed "Twenty Flight Rock". Little Richard, Fats Domino and Gene Vincent also appeared in the 1956 film, which sparked off riots and marked the beginnings of youth culture. However, the following year, while the movie was being screened around the United States, Liberty shelved "Twenty Flight Rock" as a single and decided to promote the ballad "Sittin' in the Balcony" which became a US Top 20 hit.

Subsequently, the charismatic Eddie Cochran starred alongside Mamie Van Doren in another teen classic, Untamed Youth (1957, directed by Howard W. Koch). The singer also toured Australia with Little Richard, the Everly Brothers and Gene Vincent and released his debut album, Singin' To My Baby, in 1958. As Capehart subsequently admitted, "the selection of songs on the first album was a broad general cross-section. We were looking and hoping that something would come out of the album to give Eddie more identity as a singer."By the middle of that year, the producer was beginning to despair of ever following up Cochran's first hit, after "Drive-In Show" and the next four singles all flopped. The two finally hit their stride with the infectious "Summertime Blues", one minute 59 seconds of pure adolescent angst. This track only became the A-side after "One Minute To One" was rejected as too similar to "Sittin' in the Balcony".

Analysing the appeal of "Summertime Blues", written in 45 minutes, as Cochran played around with the catchy acoustic guitar riff and Capehart clapped and chimed in with lyrics, has baffled generations of critics.

A US Top Ten hit in 1958, "Summertime Blues" has since become a rock 'n' roll classic. It has been re-released (in 1968, when it again made the Top Forty), has featured in movies, and has also been successfully re-interpreted by the

American rockers Blue Cheer, by The Who on their masterful 1970 album Live At Leeds and, most recently, by the country singer Al Jackson.

"C'mon Everybody", Eddie Cochran's follow-up single, was crafted around a similar theme and made you want to dance just as much. As the song says, "When you hear that music, you can't sit still."

Later, Capehart would willingly explain his contribution to the recordings he supervised:

Primarily, I was a lyricist, but Eddie also contributed words from time to time. He would start playing a lick on guitar and we'd bring the song together from a collaboration of ideas. As a general rule, on all of the records like "Summertime Blues", "C'mon Everybody", "My Way" and "Somethin' Else", in fact all the heavy rhythm items, the mainstays were Eddie, Guybo on bass and Earl Palmer on drums.

In 1959, Cochran was featured in Go Johnny Go, directed by Paul Landres and produced by Alan Freed, the American DJ who had coined the term "rock 'n' roll". This time, Cochran sang "Teenage Heaven", another song he had written with Capehart, but Chuck Berry stole the movie.

The following January, Cochran came to Britain and toured with Gene Vincent. The 10-week series of concerts proved so popular that it was extended (a young George Harrison was said to have followed it around the north of England so he could learn to play like Eddie). Cochran also made four appearances on Granada TV's Boy Meet Girls. Taking advantage of a two- week gap in the schedule, Cochran, his fiancee Sharon Sheeley and Gene Vincent planned to fly back to the States after appearing in Bristol. On the way to Heathrow, their car crashed and Cochran was thrown through the windscreen. He died on 17 April 1960. "Three Steps To Heaven" was released posthumously and reached No 1 in Britain.

Jerry Capehart later managed the singer Glen Campbell and the impressionist Frank Gorshen, who played the Riddler in the Batman television series. He also worked as a marine surveyor and studied to become an attorney. But he was always happy to talk about Cochran.

"Eddie was one of the innovators of rock 'n' roll. He set standards that people are still trying to achieve," Capehart said in 1991. Capehart was diagnosed with brain cancer a month before his death in Nashville, where he had gone to pitch a new song called "Summertime Blues No 2".

Jerry Neil Capehart, songwriter and manager: born 1929; married (two sons); died Nashville, Tennessee 7 June 1998.

I had no idea of Jerry's credentials or achievements . He talked about Eddie Cochran and Eddie dying in car wreck, but, I just let it blow by. Today, I am honored that Jerry liked my singing, and his comments he made about me. When I sang at Church, I noticed tears in his eyes at times.

First Group I sang with

It wasn't long until Jerry put a singing group together, two girls and myself. Jerry played guitar and Jim Martin(AKA Jimmy Stivers)played piano.

Jim Martin was playing piano in a club to support his family at the time. He became a Christian and knew if he went back to the club, he wood drink. Peg and myself bought a business with the understanding, Jim would run the business. Part of the business was delivering ice to local construction companies and cafes. I helped out by running the ice rout each morning.

God gave me my first Song

One morning as I was driving down the road , God gave me my first Song. I didn't understand what had happened. That night at practice, I told Jerry I had written a song, and he ask me to sang it. After he listen to the song, he told me several things to change to make the song better. Once again I had no idea I was singing with a man that had worked and managed people like Glen Campbell.

This was the first miracle in my life and the beginning of God giving me many songs.

If God opens the door for you to do something, do it. One morning I was asked to sing in the Church Choir. I really wanted to but was scarred to death. This was before I met Jerry Capehart.

The Words of the song I wrote about this, say it better than me writing about it.

"God's Been Faithful "

Verse one

I struggled down the aisle to the choir one Sunday Morn. My knees were really shaking as we sang the first chord. From the back row of the Choir to the first special I ever sang, I've Found God to be faithful through the years **Second verse**

From that little Country choir, into the World I was soon to go. From town to town we traveled. Sometimes it was hard to go. But in ever situation I've found God to be faithful through the years.

Chorus:

Through the years there's been trials, but joy beyond compare. Every time we faced a problem, He was there. When I became discouraged struggling to go on. I found God to be faithful through the years.

This was the beginning of an Amazing Journey with my Friend (The Holy Spirit) and meeting people I never dreamed of meeting. I believe you will find this book interesting as I share the stories of friends I made along the way.


Master Life

As we became acquainted with all, we learned that the only work Jim was qualified to do was play drums and the piano. His current job was playing piano in a bar in Joplin.

Peggy and I were almost out of debt and making good money, so we purchase a business, with the understanding, Jim would run the business. At first things went pretty good, and life was ok. I don't know how it all started but, when Justin would come in from school, he would stop at the Business. The next thing I knew Jim was teaching Just to play a bass guitar. Life was good, Justin was learning to play the bass and once a week our Music group would meet at the Church to practice. This is what I was told: While Jim was in prison, he became so down and out, he was laying in his cell, on a cot, in a fetal position, about to die, Every night a guard would come by Jim's cell, and say to him, don't "give up". After awhile, Jim would get up and talk with God and read the Bible, he read every red letter word, Jesus Spoke. The most High God spoke" **Restoration"** to Jim Bakker.

As this man told me about Jim's life in prison, God gave me the rest of the words to the song, **"Early In The Morning"**

I had just finished writing the song, "Early In The Morning", when we were ask to sing on The Jim Bakker Show again. After we sing, Jim ask me, did you ever do anything with that song you were writing. I said yes, it is finished, but I have not made a track for it yet. **Jim:** can you sing some of it for me. **Gary:** Sure, I can. After I sang the song to him, he struggle for words to say. Then, he said, I've never had people say good things about me. One other thing, his mother in-law told me she had never seen Jim respond as he did, no knowing what to say, to "Early In The Morning"

Verse one I found myself on the Righway of heart break and destruction. Searching for answers for my yesterdays, when I heard a voice whisper, don't be defeated. Reep your trust in Jesus His love for you is still the same. (Chorus) Verse Two I went back and read all the Words of Jesus. Lord became more than just a Word written in Red. In my search for answers I met the God of "Restoration", by his Grace and Mercy, he forgave me of my sin. (Choris)

Verse three I know the God of "Restoration" heals the Broken Hearted. His Grace is sufficient for our yesterdays. If we listen to His voice, we'll not be defeated. No matter what we do. His love for us is still the same.

Chorus Early in the morning I talk to Jesus. I get down on my knees and say. Thank you father for restoration. It's by your Grace and Mercy that I live today.

Gary Paxton Story

At this time in our lives, Peg and myself started traveling to Branson, Missouri to sing on shows.

Branson has long been a popular destination for vacationers from Missouri and around the country. The collection of entertainment theaters along 76 Country Boulevard (and to a lesser extent along Shepherd of the Hills Expressway), including <u>Dolly Parton's Stampede</u>, has increased Branson's popularity as a tourist destination.

It was during this time we created many precious memories with singers and song writers in Branson. One of which was About **Gary Paxton.**

Gary Sanford Paxton, born Larry Wayne Stevens in Coffeyville, Kansas May 18, 1939, died July 17, 2016 in

Branson, Missouri from complications of heart surgery and liver failure. He was 77.

After surviving an abusive childhood, Paxton began writing songs as therapy. As a teenager he formed the duo Skip & Flip scoring several hit records. He then hit the top of the charts producing the hits "Alley Oop" (which he also sang lead on) and "Monster Mash". www.nytimes.com In 1975, Paxton won the Best Inspirational Grammy for his album The Astonishing, Outrageous, Amazing, Incredible, Unbelievable, Different World of Gary S. Paxton, which contained his oft-recorded devotional song "He Was There All the Time".

The rock'n'roll producer wild man didn't exactly fit in with the God-fearing folk of the country and gospel epicentre.

Remembered Gary, "I'd walk along the streets, with my long blonde hair down to my waist. They were not going to let hippies come into their town in 1970. I wore boots up to my knees and wore a flag for a cape and would walk along with my songs in a paper bag. I kept going into places with my songs dressed like that, and the police kept arresting me. I became partners with Thomas Wayne [the singer who'd hit in 1959 with "Tragedy"]. He and I were going to become the next Skip & Flip, so we cut a rock and roll song 'On The Highway' but nobody put it out. He drank a lot, and we both did a lot of drugs.

Thomas Wayne committed suicide. I went to his funeral and I believe God said to me, 'You'll be next if you don't change.' I was walking around for four months after, completely stoned and kept hearing this voice in my head. I was walking up and down Music Row, and there was a little Christian bookstore and a church there. It said 'Church Of Christ' on it. Don Pinto was an incredible pastor. Michael W Smith and Amy Grant went there, Amy was about 15 or 16. So I went to the church, drunk out of my mind. They said I ought to come back. So I did the next week and Rev Pinto said, 'You need to get saved. . . saved from yourself.' So I went down the front, got saved and baptized and that was the last time that I ever touched drugs or alcohol. What was weird about that was my body went into shock and I had to go into hospital."

After his dramatic conversion Paxton began writing gospel songs. But in the meantime some of his country songs he was writing began to enjoy major success. Don Gibson made "Woman (Sensuous Woman)" the number one country song in the nation and Paxton was nominated for a Grammy for Song Of The Year. Roy Clark had a number one hit with "Honeymoon Feelin" the following year (1974). Paxton would continue to work with mainstream country music even after getting involved with gospel and contemporary Christian music. His hit list as a songwriter includes "Travelin' Light" for George Hamilton IV, "One Day At A Time" for Don Gibson, "The Great Divide" for Roy Clark, "Don't Let The Good Times Fool You" for Melba Montgomery, "Pictures On Paper" for Jeris-Ross and "If I'm Losing You" for Billy Walker.

When I met Gary Paxton

I was having a monthly singing at The Neosho Hall. I invited The Branson Gospel Singer Songwriter Association to come and perform in Neosho. I was told Gary Paxton was planning on being there and this would be his first time in many years, to make a public appearance. Gary had been in seclusion because someone tried to kill him.

It was almost time to start and no sign of Gary Paxton, until I looked to my left, and saw this character with long hair dressed in Red Suit, and Red Tennie Lamas(Boots.) All at once I thought, that must be Gary Paxton. Then I thought, I'll probably be ran out of town over this concert.

This was a Gaither style concert with all the performers make a Choir. As it happened, I was setting right behind Gary Paxton and could see he was very nervous. When it was Gary's time to sing, He grabbed the mike and explained how nervous he was and ask everyone to pray with him. It was very obvious , he was for real. After he prayed, he started singing the song. "He Was There All The Time". I have never been so blessed in all my years of attending concerts. Gary Paxton Told me this.

Thomas Wayne committed suicide. I went to his funeral and I believe God said to me, 'You'll be next if you don't

change.'Gary reached over and touched his friend and found his friend's body cold and hard like stone. His thoughts were, death is very final. After this visit, Gary quit drugs and started writing Gospel Music. All the time Gary was living wrong, turning from God, he finally realized God was waiting for him to come to him, all the time.

Chisai Child's Story

Crawford & Co was invited to Branson to join with local Artist to raise money to build a new Church. Chisai was the MC and between Artist I started talking to her, sharing with her, how God was giving me songs.

Several years later on our way to our place on Table Rock, I noticed someone had opened a New Theater just outside of Roaring River. On our way back home, I pulled into the parking lot and went inside to get information about the show. To my surprise, Chisai Child's was the new owner. I told her Crawford & Co would be glad to help her if she would like for us to come and sing. She said she would appreciate Crawford & Co to come and be in the show. This was the beginning of a wonderful relationship with Chisai. Just like all the people we have met, we had no idea, how important the people were or anything about their accomplishments.

Crawford & Co made several trips to Roaring River and sang for Chisai, before she closed the Theater. However, Peg and myself had become pretty good friends with Chisai, so when we went to Branson we would visit her and keep up with what was going on.

We have found when we have helped others, we end up receiving so much more.

Friends Remember **The "Belle of Branson"** by: <u>Grant Sloan</u> 3/2/2017 - BRANSON, Mo. - A trailblazer for the city of Branson has died. Chisai Childs was known for "bringing the glitter" to Branson, along with some of the city's biggest names. "You can't think of entertainment in Branson and not think of Chisai," says Branson Mayor, Karen Best.

"She's one of the reasons that we have the great entertainment that we have."

Childs, simply known as Chisai to many of her friends, was an entertainer from an early age. She got into show biz at the age of six, was named "Miss Talented Teen" in 1965, toured several USO shows and performed at locations across the country.

But maybe her biggest impact was helping put Branson on the map by bringing in names like Boxcar Willie, Doug Gabriel and Shoji Tabuchi, among many others. "I was just talking to Shoji the other day and asked him to tell me how he got to Branson," says Best, "and it was real easy for him; he got this big grin, big smile on his face, and it was one word, 'Chisai.''

But those who knew her say Chisai didn't just have an eye for talent, she also knew how to sell talent to the millions of Branson visitors.

"When they first started doing the shows, they were just dressing anyway," says long-time friend and creator of the Terry Music Awards, Terry Beene.

"She brought the glitter and the glitz, and that's why they have it today," he says. "Mike Patrick over at the Grand Country, The Presley's -- they've all got beautiful uniforms and that's because of Chisai."

Chisai not only upped the production value of the shows in Branson, she also had her own television show called "Chisai and the Ozarks" and a radio show with Boxcar Willie called "Boxcar's Bandstand."

Chisai also played a large role in bringing the "Terry Music Awards," which recognizes performers and the men and women behind the scenes, from Texas to Missouri.

Chisai promoted Crawford & Co in Branson, every time she could. She introduced us to Terry Bean and made it

possible for us to pat of the "Terry Music Awards",introduced us to Brent Mabe(Bald Knobbers) and this gave us the opportunity to perform pre show for "The Bald Knobbers" and take part in "The Bald Knobbers" celebrating 55 Years, and many other events. Branson is not the same, without having Chisai there to meet us, for fellowship and food.

It was this time in our lives, when we started important products from different Countries around the World. Since cassette tapes were big at this time in the World, and my love for music, we decided to important cassette tapes.one of us. In my spare time, I would call on Churches and any place I thought might buy cassette tapes. Early one morning on my way to my work at Webb City Bank, I came across **Stone Castle Church.** A man(**Chaplin Hughes**), was standing in the door, so I stopped and started talking with him. I Found out they had moved from California to Webb City and purchased the Church. About that time someone came out of the Church and asked what is wrong? Ken yelled back at them, it is all right, he is one of us.

My thoughts, what am I one of. I was a little concerned about the new people I had just met.

In the weeks to follow, I would stop brand visit with Ken and Joan. I came to know they worked with people that needed help to change their lives. Many if not all lived in the Church or other properties they owned.

As we talked one day, Ken said, we have a bunch of Bats living in the Belfry. How can we get rid of them. My thoughts were, why are you asking me, you are Chaplin Hughes, I would prayer them to leave. That weekend our family went tour place at the Lake. In the middle of the night, I woke up with the thought my mother could be healed. Why I was thinking this, I don't know. However, not knowing at first what I was doing. I ask God, if my mother can be healed, how about Cheryl(My Friend with cerebral palsy)being healed and how about Pastor Chester? God said, take them to your mother's house and pray for them. My thoughts; Great, I can do that. God said, and go to Webb City and pray for the Bats to leave that Church. My thoughts—I'm a Banker, respected man, praying for Bats to leave a Church. I didn't say no nor did I say yes. As was very high or close to God when this happened, but as the days went by, I became weaker and weaker. As we reached the Belfry, I realized I had not thought about what I would say or do. It was time to do something, everyone was there and watching. I raise my hand, believing once I prayed, the bats would go flying out. With my hand raised, I said, in the name of the Lord, you Bats, leave this Belfry, nothing happened, quickly, I said, or prepare to die. Amen.

At this point, all I knew was, I did what I told God I would do. Then, Chaplin Hughes, got real serious, visibly touched, seeing I wasn't joking. I can't remember what he said, but he spoke encouraging words. I left for work.

Since 1982, I have learned to do what God tells me to do. He has a very good reason. You make feel silly, uncomfortable, don't let it stop you. God knows what he is doing. What he has asked you do to probably has more to do with the other person, than you. However, you will be blessed. I don't care what it is God ask you to do, do it. Don't miss a Blessing.

Back at work a several months later, I received a call from a man, asking about investing money with the Bank. As he spoke I recognized it was Chaplin Hughes. I said, how are you Chaplin Hughes, he said, who is this? I said, Batman. He said, Gary is this you, we have been looking for you. Those Bats left the Church. My reply, that is good, but I don't care, I did what God ask me to do. The News had spread to all their friends even to TBN, I am Batman (Story to be continued after Obituary)

Mrs. Joan (Josie Pearline) W. Hughes, 95, of Webb City, Mo., departed this life into Glory on Monday, April 20, 2015, at her residence, after a recent decline in health. She has been a resident of Webb City, since 1994, moving from Riverside, Calif. Joan entered this life on Jan. 6, 1920, in rural Barton County, Mo., the only daughter born to the late John and Leona (Giger) Waring.
